**TEENS LEARN ABOUT MONEY AND LIFE WITH

NASHVILLE, Tenn.—*New York Times* bestselling author and personal finance expert Dave Ramsey’s new version of *Generation Change* helps teens learn more about how to make responsible decisions now to help them in the future. The new nine lesson Bible study teaches teens about their relationship with God and how to find true value in their lives.

In *Generation Change*, Ramsey’s daughter Rachel Cruze joins him in teaching teens that their value can be found in what God created them to be, and how to use that value to help others, live a more rewarding life with Christ, and how to better handle their money.

“Generation Change removes the chaos of a teen’s life and replaces it with a message of hope,” says Cruze. “It shows teens how to prevent financial heartache and live a life free of debt.”

Within each of these series, Cruze and Ramsey, along with author and speaker Jon Acuff, host the video lessons that help lead into discussion and other activities.
